Suratun Naas - The People - Surah 114 - Makkan

In the name of Allah, the Most Beneficent, the Most Merciful.

[1] Say, I seek protection with the Lord of People,

[2] The King of People, [3] The God of People,

[4] From the evil of the sneaking whisperer,

[5] The one who whispers in the hearts of People, [6] From among the Jinn and People.

Surah Naas is the last Surah in the Qur'an, surah 114. It is a Makki surah and has 6 verses. Allah has given us this surah as a gift which He did not give to any people before us. In this surah, we praise Allah with His 3 qualities: Rabb (Sustainer), Malikiyat (Ownership), Ilaah(God). Allah is our creator and He provides us with everything we need to live. So we should ask him for what we need. He is the King and ruler of all the worlds. Lastly, Allah is the only God for all the worlds. No one else has these 3 qualities.

After mentioning these 3 qualities, we are asking Allah to protect us from one thing. That is from the evil of the whispering one. The whispering can be from jinn, shaytan or a human. Shaytan likes to whisper evil and go away and make us do bad deeds. We need to stay away from shaytan and people who stop us from becoming good Muslims. To protect us, we should recite last 2 surahs regularly.

Surah Naas and Surah Falaq are part of the family of surahs known as the muaw'wadhatain "The Two Protectors". Many virtues have been mentioned about these 2 surahs. In these surahs, Allah has taught us to ask for protection from many things. Allah wants us to be super safe. These surahs are like two locks that can protect us. When we recite both of these surahs together, we are using two locks that will keep us super safe from harm! Greatest blessing of Allah is Imaan/faith and we need to protect it at all times.

Surah Fatiha is at the beginning of the Quran and these two surahs are at the end of the Quran. In Surah Fatiha, we ask for Allah's help and in these 2 surahs we are also asking for His help and protection. It shows that from the beginning to the end of our life we should turn to Allah and should continue to ask for His help.

In Surah Falaq, we are asking for protection from the harms to our body and in Surah Naas, we are asking for protect our iman and Islam. These 2 surahs should be read for protection every morning and evening, especially when going to sleep. The Prophet (PBUH) read these surahs every night before going to sleep and blew on his hands and rubbed his hands over his body.
